This is problematic knowing that most of exams are long and require a great deal of preparation, is there a way to overcome this problem?</p>	<p>Preparing schedules is one of the tasks undertaken by the admission and Registration Deanship, and due to the large numbers of students and courses, sometimes exams take place on the same day. We will submit this recommendation to the higher management to consider the possibility of coordination between the college and deanship of admission and registration in order to organize the courses timetables as well as test schedules in an appropriate way.</p>	<p>Send a draft for distribution of courses to the deanship of admission and registration to ensure there are no core subjects on the same day, especially those subjects require effort and time to review.</p>

And if so, why is it not applied to the female section?	<p>One track was chosen in the students' section which include five subjects of the commercial and Saudi law, that considered to be the most suitable subjects for the market and its needs and because there is no demand for the other tracks.</p> <p>But if there is a need to open all tracks, and if the college has the manpower capabilities for that, so all the three tracks will be completely applied, developed and updated.</p>	The draft of updating the study plan includes a proposal which enable the student to choose the subjects that suit him from each track, while emphasizing the need to define mandatory subjects. In other words, if the student chooses the commercial law track so the largest share will be for the commercial law subjects.

Is there a possibility for partnership related to this matter or cooperation with law firms to facilitate student training?	<p>There are many memoranda of understanding that the university has held with reputable law firms.</p> <p>The task of nominating students for law firms is facilitated by the increasing demand from law firms and legal institutions on law college students for the purpose of cooperative training and employment , and that is due to the distinguished reputation of college students in the legal market.</p>	<p>Coordination with the law firms that the university has memoranda of understanding with, in order to facilitate finding training courses for college students during the summer periods.</p> <p>Executive steps will be taken in this matter, and students will be informed about it. Students should apply for the college in an appropriate time to allow the college consider the possibility of finding training places for them.</p>

There is a preliminary talk about preparing for a special building for the college of law in one of the buildings that are currently being built by the university and this gives the university more freedom regarding the number of classrooms, divisions, lectures , schedules, in addition to the events and activities held by the college.	The need for an independent building that meets the needs of the law college has become necessary provided that it include a large theatre to accommodate the activities, events, workshops, and conferences related to the college, and it should also include a headquarters for the legal clinic and the mock court , and small halls for holding seminars.
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
